
Aveanna Healthcare's COVID-19 Response Plan

Safety first. We've rolled out our own Aveanna Safety Pledge to help keep patients and employees safe.

Our nurses will pledge to go out for work and essential needs ONLY. Our families pledge to do the same. Because when we commit to keep each other safe, we all feel better about our care.



Policies and procedures are in place. We have adopted protocols to triage and limit exposure of potential patient and caregiver COVID-19 cases.

We also have clinical protocols developed to care for COVID-19 positive patient cases. We are successfully caring for more than 50 today.



Suiting up. We are properly using PPE according to CDC guidelines and state-specific protocols.

Best practices for infection control are communicated and followed in patient homes, locations, and support centers.



Reducing risk. Protocols have been implemented to limit exposure for our patients/families and caregivers.

Caregivers' schedules are adjusted to minimize the number of caregivers in the home.

Virtual nurse supervision visits are provided as appropriate.

Virtual conferencing is utilized to complete the intake/referral form and admission process. Physical assessments are done virtually with RN in the home.

Teletherapy is leveraged to provide OT, SLP, PT, and ABA therapy.

Our caring doesn't stop during a crisis. Neither does our mission.


Together with you, we're making a difference one patient and one referral at a time. Together, we will all get through this.
